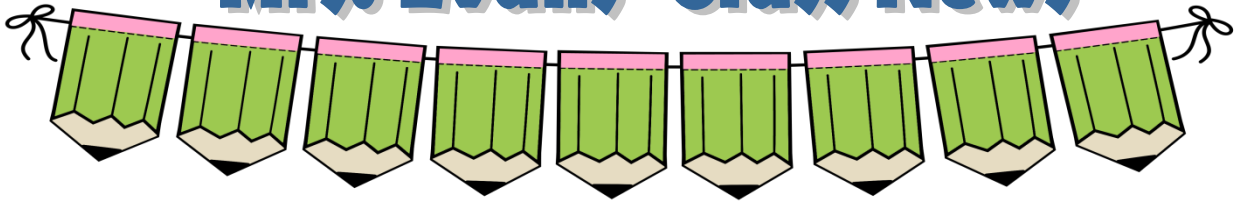


# Mrs. Evans' Class News
